## Little changes big differences.

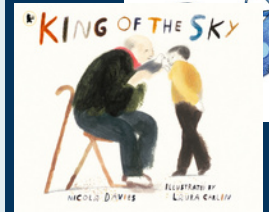
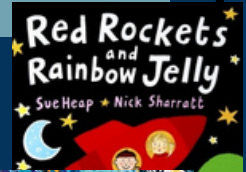
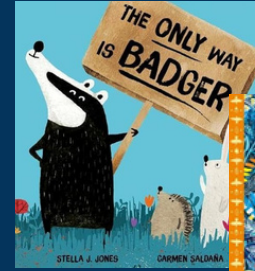
.A small premises update, Some of you may have noticed work has begun on our new sensory garden on the playground, this will support inclusion and calm tranquil spots for play.
